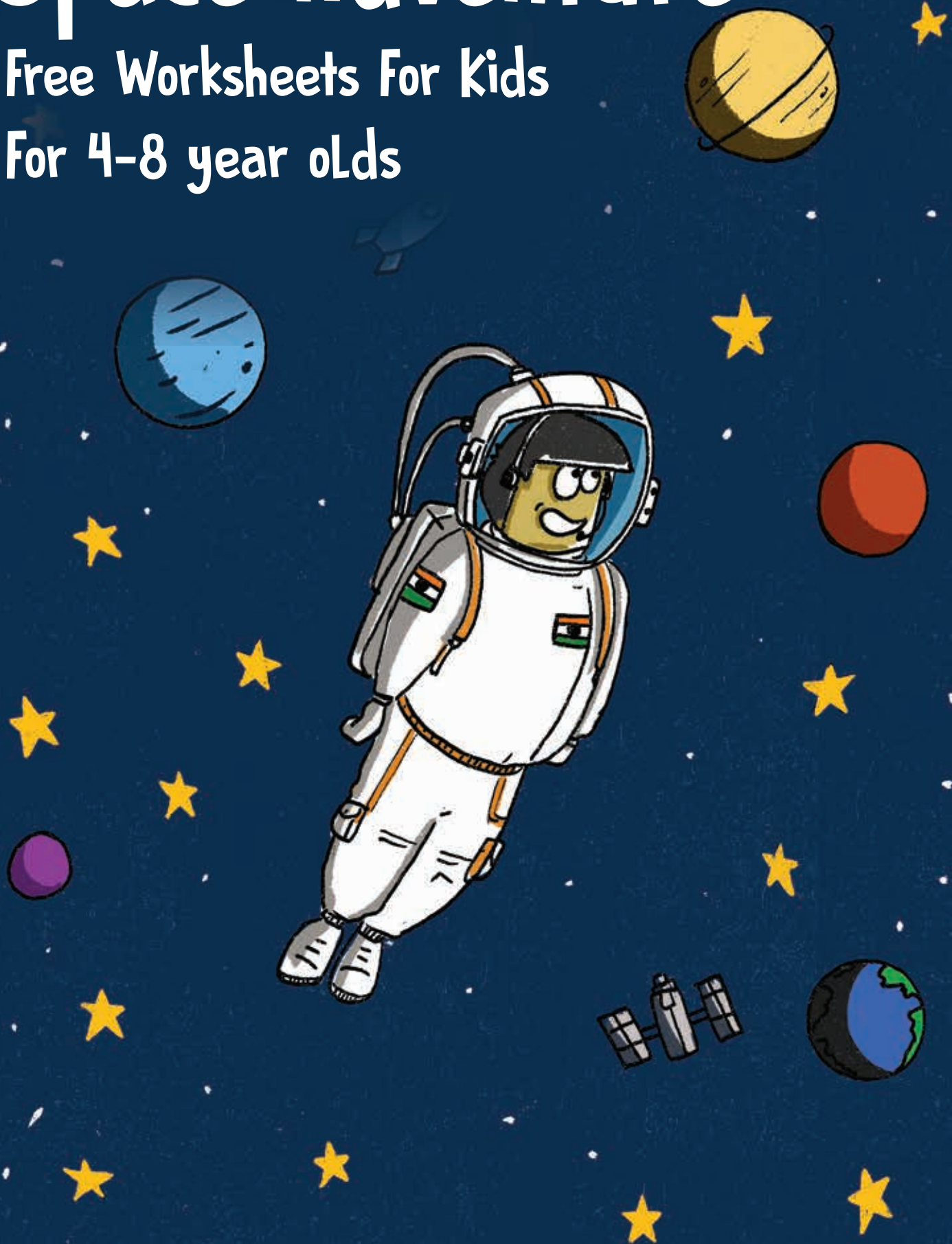

In Space	Not In Space



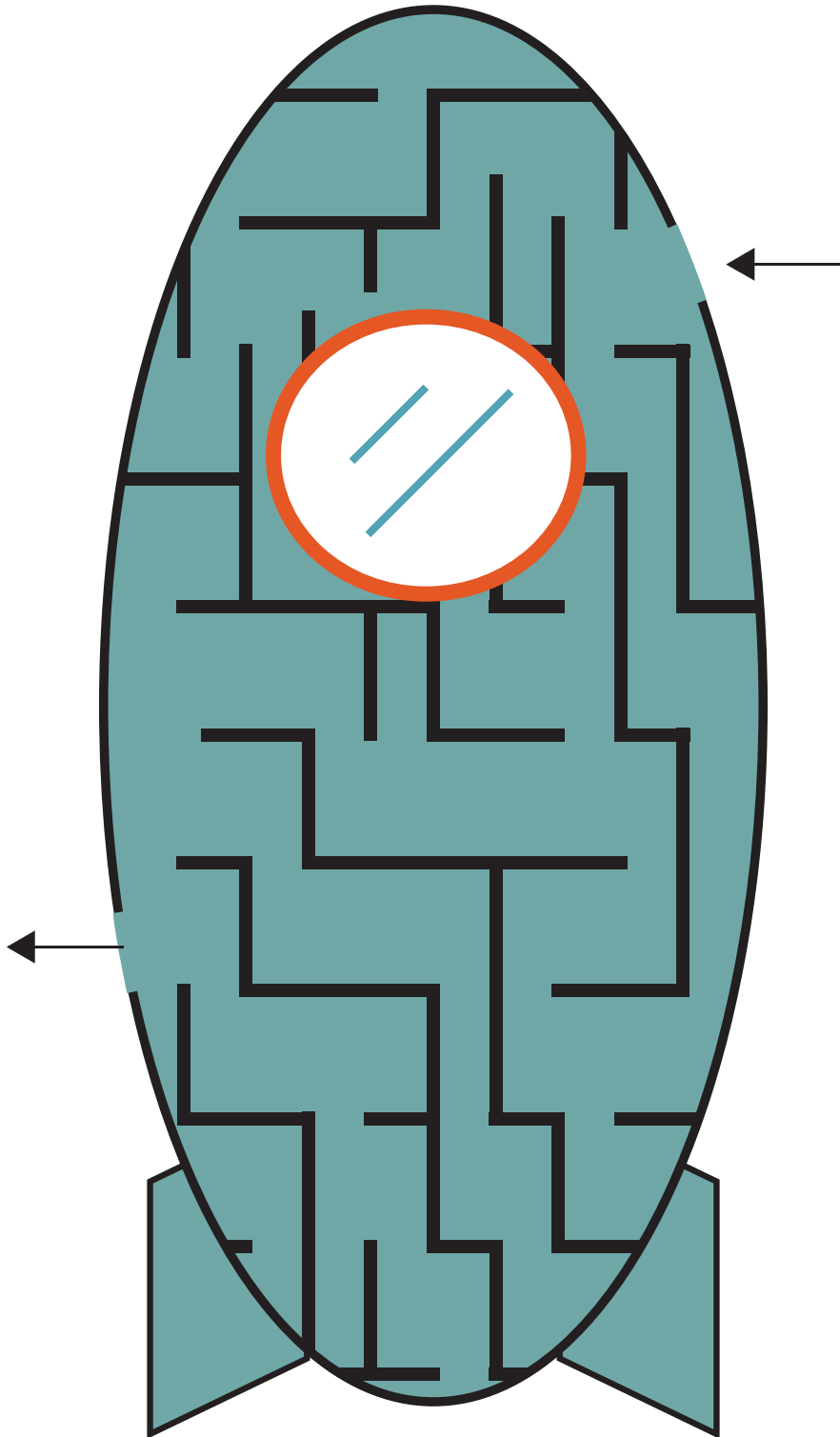
How this activity helps?

Encourage the child to describe each element of space.

# Rocket Maze

*Help your child find the way out of the maze. Then, discuss about what a rocket is.*



*How this activity helps?*

*Your child uses logic to solve the maze puzzle.*

*Encourage your child to narrate a story about the maze in the rocket.*

Jupiter



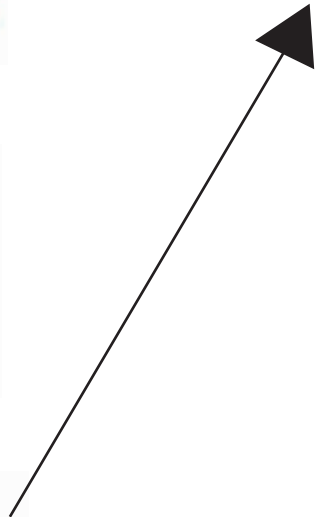
Satellite

*How this activity helps?*

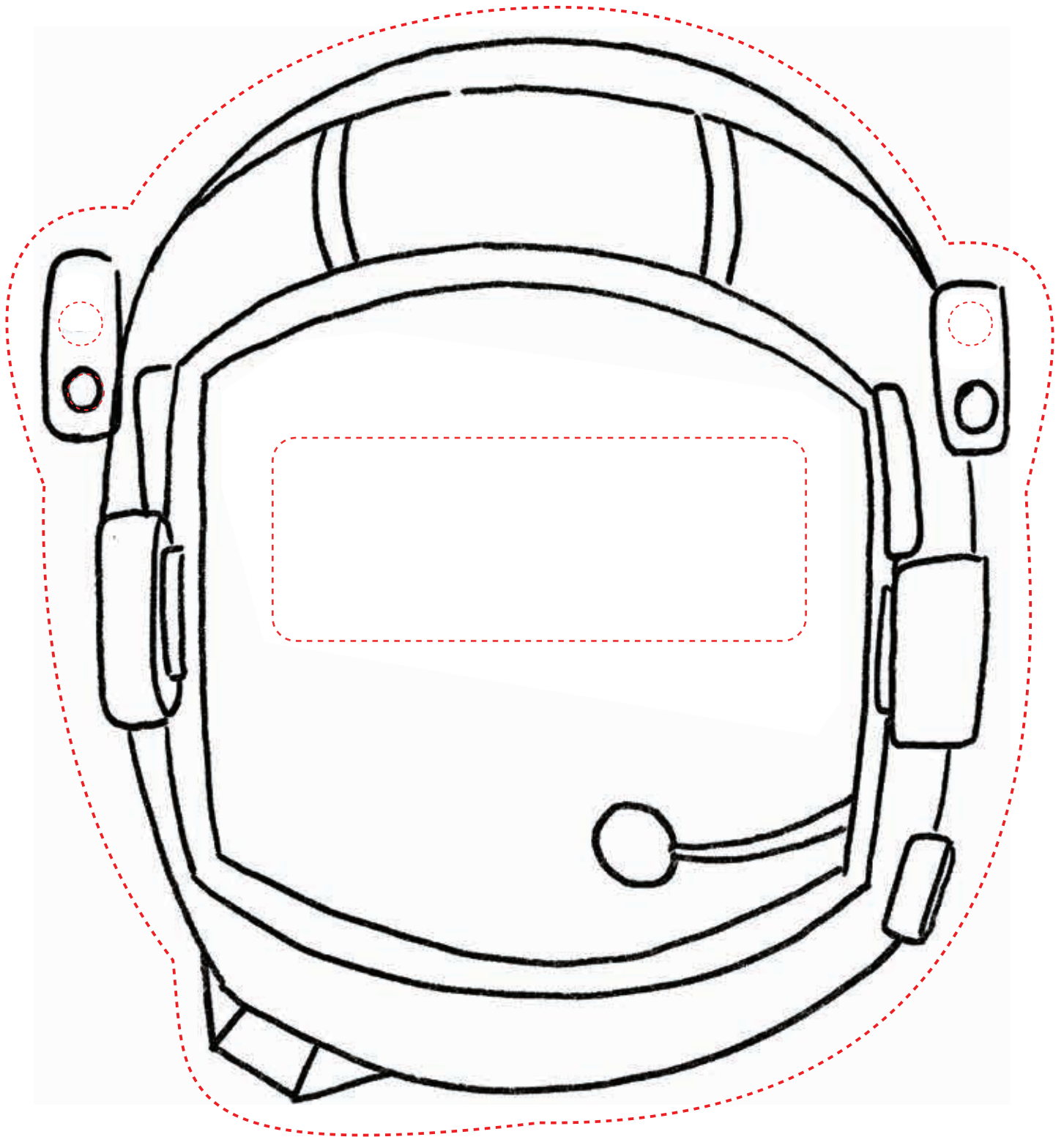
*Your child identifies different elements of space by their names.*

*Your child creates a colourful astronaut face mask from scratch and then pretend plays. Encourage your child to travel to a planet and pretend to be an astronaut. What does the planet have?*
